
Improvement of CPR quality among emergency medical service providers in Out-of-Hospital Cardiac Arrest

Progress


- Applied for funding (Trygfonden og Laerdal)

Challenges

Gathering data (approx. 25% missing)

Patient identification (approx. 50% missing unique patient ID number)

Technical limitations in data / bias



What's next (3-6 months)

Maintain and improve dataflow and compliance

Setting up automatic data-import from 3 different sources (CAD, PPJ, CR)

Training of all EMS in Copenhagen in optimal use of live feedback

Reconfigure all devices to show live feedback

Phase 2 data gathering
